

Minutes of the Full Council meeting of the above Council held in the Council Rooms at Meadowside Leisure Centre, Whiteley on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2017 at 7.15pm.

Resident Paul Cox asked if the car park at the back of Angelica Way could be closed at 8pm to prevent the noise and disruption of staff leaving when the restaurants close. **The Chairman will raise with Whiteley Shopping.** 

Resident Pat Wright thanked Cllr Jenkins for helping with noise concerns raised by Sorrel Drive residents due to out of hours work at Solent Lodge. The assistance and support is much appreciated.

Mr Wright also raised complaints about the inadequate grass cutting and hedge maintenance by Winchester City Council. He would like to see the Town Council take on the management as he feels standards would be higher.

Mr Wright also raised concerns about misuse of disabled parking bays in the leisure centre car park, dangerous parking in Parkway and parking on pavements in Sorrel Drive. It was noted that parking in the leisure centre car park is not always monitored, the Police will not deal with Parkway parking unless it causes an obstruction. H-bar lining has been requested for the Sorrel Drive dropped kerb access to the play area.

Resident Keith Slack reported that the broken bollard at the bottom of Saffron Way is a trip hazard. **The bollard has been reported to HCC.**
