



Whiteley Parish Council

Minutes of the Full Council meeting of the above Council held at Meadowside Leisure Centre, Whiteley on Monday 3rd October 2011 at 7.15pm.

3.1 Report from Meon Valley Safer Neighbourhood Team and to receive any concerns from residents Owen Reeves advised prior to the meeting that incidents remain low.

3.2 Report from County Councillor Cllr Allgood reported that an outline planning application for Lady Betty's Drive will be submitted shortly. The number of units proposed has reduced from 90 to 75 with fewer two bedroom and more four bedroom units. Those on the main street will have front gardens. These changes are in response to the consultation process.

HCC is discussing the National Planning Policy Framework consultation and considers that the social benefits of development should be given equal weight to the economic benefits.

There is a consultation on changes to library opening times, required in response to the need to cut costs.

Cllr Diffey asked whether respondents to the Lady Betty's Drive consultation received individual replies from HCC. Cllr Allgood to check.

Cllr Achwal asked whether the Lady Betty's scheme would still include affordable houses. Cllr Allgood advised that Local Plan policies would apply.

Cllr Croft-Phillips asked how libraries such as Locks Heath would be affected by changes. Cllr Allgood advised each library has been individually assessed. Clerk to circulate details of consultation.

Cllr Allgood suggested the Parish Council could ask for a neighbourhood library in Whiteley.

3.3 Reports from District Councillors Cllr Achwal and Cllr Newman-McKie circulated a report prior to the meeting. Bin collection days are changing from 17th October, Whiteley bins will be collected on Wednesdays.

Case work for the month has included resolving complaints about hedge cutting in a number of areas and dealing with concerns from a resident about dangerous parking in Leafy Lane.

Cllr Jenkins asked why two sets of information were sent out at the same time regarding bin collection changes. Cllr Newman-McKie advised this was a Royal Mail error, the mailings should have been staggered.
