Minutes of the Full Council meeting of the above Council held at Meadowside Leisure Centre, Whiteley on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2011 at 7.15pm.

1. **To receive apologies for absence** PCSO Owen Reeves.

**3.1 Report from Meon Valley Safer Neighbourhood Team and to receive any concerns from residents** PCSO Owen Reeves provided a report prior to the meeting. Policing priorities for the next quarter were agreed to be: speeding on Parkway and Yew Tree Drive, dangerous parking in Leafy Lane and antisocial behaviour throughout Whiteley.

**3.2 Report from County Councillor** The Chairman noted the death of Councillor Freddie Allgood with sadness and regret.

**3.3 Reports from District Councillors** Cllr Achwal and Cllr Newman-McKie circulated a report prior to the meeting. Whiteley Wanderers Football Club have been presented with Club of the Year Award 2011 at the Winchester District Sports Awards 2011.

Yellow lines are now in place on Rookery Avenue and Yew Tree Drive junction.

A new footpath is being laid from the bus stop hard standing to the pedestrian crossing on Whiteley Way in response to requests from residents.
