Highways and Transport Committee

Minutes of a meeting of the above Committee held at Meadowside Leisure Centre, Whiteley on Wednesday 22nd May 2013 at 8.35pm.

1. **To elect a chairman for the ensuing year** Roland Diffey elected.
2. **To elect a vice-chairman** Chris Harper elected.
3. **To receive apologies for absence** None.
4. **To receive declarations of interest regarding agenda items** None.
5. **To adjourn meeting to allow participation by members of the public**
Resident Keith Slack asked for yellow lines in Marjoram Way, resident Brenda Hatch asked for a crossing on Yew Tree Drive into Gull Coppice, Cllr Croft-Phillips asked for a crossing at the doctors' surgery end of Yew Tree Drive, Cllr Wye asked the Parish Council and Fareham BC were working together to secure crossings. **The Chairman advised that yellow lines in Marjoram are being considered by WCC, HCC has agreed a crossing is required into Gull Coppice and Cllr Stallard has advised work will start late this year or early 2014. Another crossing would be for FBC to pursue. Fareham BC does not recognise parish councils so it is difficult to work together.**
6. **Meeting resumed to consider the following agenda items**

6.1 To receive update on the yellow line review regarding the parking issues in Parkway and elsewhere. **Clerk to ask WCC for an update.**

6.2 To receive update on the campaign to pursue provision of an emergency route out of Whiteley (for the Winchester side of Whiteley) should Whiteley Way be blocked between the north entrance to Parkway and the R2 roundabout. **Clerk to ask HCC for an update.**

6.3 To progress campaign for improvements to Leafy Lane to reduce use by business park traffic. Proposal to campaign for single yellow lines with timed weekday parking restrictions subject to local consultation. **Clerk to ask WCC for an update.**

6.4 To receive update on requests to HCC/Police Road Safety Unit including maintenance requests. **Nothing major at present.**

7. **To identify any unmanaged risks within this committee's remit** None.
8. **Review effectiveness of communication, development of links with other community organisations and support for local democracy through making information more widely available** Update on the committee's work will be included in the annual report in the June edition of the Whiteley Voice.
