

# Whiteley Town Council

## Highways and Transport Committee

Minutes of a meeting of the above Committee held in the Council Rooms at Meadowside Leisure Centre, Whiteley on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2014 at 9.25pm.

1. **To receive apologies for absence** Tasmin Smith.
2. **To receive declarations of interest regarding agenda items** None.
3. **To adjourn meeting to allow participation by members of the public**  
Resident Brenda Hatch asked what was going to be done about parking in Marjoram Way. **The Chairman advised that parking is being monitored by the Town Council, Winchester City Council and Whiteley Shopping. Whiteley Shopping speak to staff parking in Marjoram and ask them to park elsewhere. Vehicles are legally permitted to park outside of the white lines. There are no immediate plans for yellow lines.**
4. **Meeting resumed to consider the following agenda items**

4.1 To review the Council's adopted Highways Strategy Paper November 2010 **Some updating was proposed to the paper authored by ex councillor Roland Diffey in the light of new information. The suggested amendments were agreed,**

4.2 To receive update on the campaign to pursue provision of an emergency route out of Whiteley (for the Winchester side of Whiteley) should Whiteley Way be blocked between the north entrance to Parkway and the R2 roundabout **Provision of an alternative route out of Whiteley remains a priority but more than one option has emerged with the plans for North Whiteley.**

4.3 To review parking issues in Whiteley **Whiteley Shopping Steering Group is monitoring parking in residential areas around the shopping centre. Cllr Butter reported that displaced parking in Sweethills and Clydesdale as a result of yellow lines on Yew Tree Drive is also a problem.**

4.4 To receive update on requests to HCC/Police Road Safety Unit including maintenance requests - please forward requests to Clerk **prior to meeting.**

- 4.4.1 To consider items relating to the HCC Traffic Management and Minor Works programme 2015/2016, report on request made **The Chairman met with Cllr Stallard to look at safety issues at the top of Lady Bettys Drive. Requests for vegetation to be cut back to be made. HCC's safety unit to be asked to look at the potential for warning signs and traffic calming.**
