Highways and Transport Committee

Minutes of a meeting of the above Committee held in the Council Rooms at Meadowside Leisure Centre, Whiteley on Wednesday 15th November 2017 at 7.47pm.

1. **To receive apologies for absence** Vivian Achwal, Pat Thew.
2. **To receive declarations of interest regarding agenda items** None.
3. **To adjourn meeting to allow participation by members of the public**
Resident Mr Putman noted the continued flooding issues at the R1 roundabout. **The Chairman advised that as there are proposals to remodel the roundabout, remedial work in the short term is unlikely.**
4. **Meeting resumed to consider the following agenda items**

4.1 To review the Council's adopted Highways Strategy Paper **Ongoing.**

4.2 To review parking issues in Whiteley including: dangerous parking on the R1 to Whiteley Way slip roads, Strawberry Track / Meadowside crossing in Thyme Ave, and complaints from residents in Mollison Rise. **The Chairman has met with residents in Gibson Close and Mollison Rise to discuss parking issues and will continue to monitor.**

4.3 To review public and community transport issues in Whiteley

4.3.1 Request from a resident for shuttle bus to Locks Heath **It is proposed to use the remaining funds from the Shopping Centre travel plan to continue the contracts for the Saturday buses to Fareham and Warsash. New services should be provided as North Whiteley progresses.**

4.3.2 Ongoing request from a resident for improved bus services **See above.**

4.3.3 To consider partnership project with Whiteley Church to set up a community care transport scheme **Ongoing. No volunteers have come forward to assist at present.**

4.3.4 Use of bus shelters in Parkway following diversion of bus route **Shelters will continue to be maintained. Remove from future agendas.**

4.4 To receive update on requests to HCC/Police Road Safety Unit including maintenance requests.

Update on repairs to speed humps in Leafy Lane **Refer to next meeting.**

5. **To identify any unmanaged risks within this committee's remit** None.
6. **Review effectiveness of communication, development of links with other community organisations and support for local democracy through making information more widely available** Continue to monitor.
