1. **To receive apologies for absence** Vivian Achwal, Hazel Croft-Phillips, Pat Thew.
2. **To receive declarations of interest regarding agenda items** None.
3. **To adjourn meeting to allow participation by members of the public**  
Members of the public asked for improved bus services. Chairman to investigate whether the Whiteley Shuttle could start earlier in the day and to research community transport opportunities.

4.1 To review the Council's adopted Highways Strategy Paper **Continue to review.**

4.2 To review parking issues in Whiteley **Parking during the build up to Christmas did not appear to cause any problems. Still some issues with unsociable parking in Angelica Way and Marjoram Way.**

4.3 To review public and community transport issues in Whiteley **Chairman to investigate volunteer run transport schemes. Conversations with the operators of Fareham and Winchester's community transport / Dial a Ride schemes indicate there has been no take up in Whiteley.**

4.4 To receive update on requests to HCC/Police Road Safety Unit including maintenance requests **Repairs and maintenance requests can be submitted directly to Hampshire County Council.**
