2. **To receive declarations of interest regarding agenda items** None.
3. **To adjourn meeting to allow participation by members of the public**  
Councillor David Jenkins asked when the planting to the Caraway play area would be completed. Chairman to check with WCC. Resident Vic Hatch asked for flooding on the Meadowside footpath near Coriander Way to be addressed, Vivian Achwal is liaising with WCC in her role as District Councillor.
4. **Meeting resumed to consider the following agenda items:**

4.1 To receive an update on Area K issues (Chairman) **Nothing to report at present.**

4.2 To receive an update on the sculpture bench project: installation of plaque (Clerk) **Plaque is ready for collection.**

4.3 To receive an update from the Skatepark User Forum held 17<sup>th</sup> November (Chairman/Clerk) **Options involving a low medium and high budget are being drawn up by local contractor Gravity Engineering in consultation with the users. Grant opportunities and fundraising ideas are being researched with the help of Gravity.**
