## Recreation and General Purposes Committee

- 1. To receive apologies for absence None.
- 2. To receive declarations of interest regarding agenda items None.
- 3. To adjourn meeting to allow participation by members of the public Resident Geoff Rogers complained about litter on the recreation ground, particularly after football matches.

  Cllr Achwal has asked WCC to increase litter collection. SERCO do not work at weekends or on bank holidays so litter was noticeable over Easter.
- 4. Meeting resumed to consider the following agenda items:
- 4.1 To receive an update on Area K issues (Chairman) **The Residents Association is** going to approach Cllr Allgood for a grant towards a grit bin.
- 4.2 To receive an update on the sculpture bench project: installation of plaque (Clerk) It was agreed to stick the plaque to the bench as the concrete is too hard to drill for screw fixings.
- 4.3 To receive an update from the Skatepark User Forum (Chairman/Clerk) **Nothing** further to report.
- 4.4 To note any outstanding play area repairs and landscape maintenance issues **The Chairman has reported repairs needed to the entrance to the Area K play area to WCC.** An order has been placed for the work.
  - 4.4.1 To receive update on repairs to timber sculpture benches. (Cllr Menzies) Cllr Menzies was thanked for looking after the benches.
- 4.5 To receive report and recommendations from Environment Champion/ Whiteley Action Group (Cllr Menzies) Cllr Menzies was thanked for her input as Environment Champion as she is retiring from the Council.
- 4.6 To consider request for floodlighting to Meadowside MUGA/tennis courts for use by local junior football teams and local organisations. **Clerk to correspond with the football club for an update on funding requirements.**
- 4.7 To receive update on management plans for the Meadowside conservation area (Chairman/Clerk) **Working party to be arranged to progress.**

- 4.8 To receive update on proposal for an outside gym area for Meadowside (Cllr Achwal) Cllr Achwal to forward quotes for maintenance to Chairman and to ask for some equipment to display at the Parish Assembly.
- 4.9 To receive update on project to install a bench in Marjoram Way (Chairman) **Bench will be installed shortly.**
