- 3. To adjourn meeting to allow participation by members of the public Resident Keith Slack raised again the need for extended GP surgery provision for North Whiteley. The Chairman confirmed that the NHS will not fund another surgery, there is considered to be sufficient capacity at the existing surgery. Fareham Borough Council has been asked to look at extending the car park.
- 4. Meeting resumed to consider the following agenda items:
- 4.1 To review issues concerning proposals for North Whiteley and reports to be made to the North Whiteley Development Forum feedback from exhibition; proposed letter to WCC. The exhibition was very well attended. Chairman to write to WCC Director of Operations to confirm the Town Council's priorities for North Whiteley: early opening of Bluebell Way onto Botley Road, early provision of schools and sports pitches, no private management companies, reinstatement of permitted development rights for existing Whiteley.

- 4.3 To review Broadband availability issues for Whiteley residents Commercial rollout is happening slowly, not yet clear which areas will require HCC funding to be upgraded.

- 4.5 Update on agreed highways priorities for Whiteley / North Whiteley (Chairman) **See item 4.1 above.**
- 4.6 To progress an emergency plan for Whiteley to review priorities in view of agenda item 4.5 above **Meeting to be arranged with HCC to finalise the emergency plan.**
