



Residents Letter August 2014

Dear Resident

The purpose of this letter is to let you know that further planned concrete work is proposed on the Cinema project. This work covers the first and second floors of the new building and requires a “power floated” finish to a high specification.

Due to the nature of concrete curing and finishing, the time period required varies on a multitude of environmental factors coupled with the design of the finished product.

In the worst case scenario the concrete can take up to 12 hours to cure and finish. We have planned the works to avoid this but there remains a small risk that the concrete activities on site may continue beyond the agreed set working hours in order to be completed to specification.

We have notified Winchester City Council of the planned works and the possibility of works overrunning into late evening. Winchester City Council has agreed that on the dates below, work can continue beyond 6pm for as short a time as possible to complete the concreting works.

We have also discussed this with the Town Council, and we can assure you we will do our utmost to minimise any inconvenience to those residents living in close proximity to the development. We will, of course, notify you again if our plans change due to circumstances beyond our control but the current programme of works are listed below.
